

On December 29, 1999, a loan agreement was established between The Walton Electric Membership Corporation and Doyle I, LLC, a generation facility of which Walton EMC was the sole owner. Doyle I, LLC was required to make quarterly principal and interest payments to Walton EMC at an interest rate equal to the rate payable to our lender, NRUCFC.

Both the note, which has been paid in full with the sale of Doyle I, LLC, and all related interest expenses are recorded as as pass-throughs on Walton EMC's books. Accordingly, this arrangement has no financial impact on WEMC's operations and are not included in the above financial statements.
















### AVERAGE MONTHLY COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL BILL
