Walton EMC is owned and democratically governed by the energy consumers we serve. That's you!

Democratic member control is one of the seven cooperative principles that distinguishes our co-op from other utilities, companies and industries. The Second Cooperative Principle: Democratic Member Control spells out the membership benefit of having a voice and a vote in cooperative business. Each customer-owner of Walton EMC is entitled to equal voting rights upon joining the co-op.

The Walton EMC Annual Meeting, held on the third Saturday in June, is a primary way our customer-owners exercise democratic control. When members participate in the annual meeting, you ensure the co-op is guided by the people it serves.

Four reasons the customer-owners of Walton EMC conduct an annual meeting:

Elect board members.

The election of customer-owners to serve as directors is the most important facet of the annual meeting. Directors represent their fellow customer-owners in setting the policies and general direction followed by Walton EMC's management and staff. In this way, the co-op is democratically governed by its customers.

Walton EMC has nine directors who represent customers-owners and communities from different geographical districts throughout the co-op's 10-county service area. A director serves a three-year term.

Each year, three board seats are up for election. In a year when their district is holding an election, Walton EMC customer-owners can read board candidate biographies at **waltonemc.com/annualmeeting** before casting a vote at the annual meeting.


Engage with fellow members.
